- Strong planning, organisational, time management and leadership skills with the ability to work both independently and part of a wider team.
- Demonstrated commitment to personal and professional development, as well as an eagerness to contribute to the ongoing evaluation and evolution of Club programming.
- Ability to travel independently with football equipment.



Required Qualifications

- Football Australia coaching accreditation
 - Pre-Academy roles require minimum C License or equivalent
 - Community roles require minimum MiniRoos Grassroots Football Certification
- Provide First Aid certification
- Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification
- Valid Working with Children Check
