Purpose and Overview

The PAC coaching role is critical to the success of the MVFC football department. The role will be responsible for the delivery of industry leading coaching across all PACs, Selection Days and Regional Masterclass Camps. Working closely with the Football Pathways Manger, the PAC Coach will have input into the annual delivery of PAC coaching and recruitment in line with the Club's philosophy of developing youth players.

Responsibilities may fall to individuals or be shared amongst a team, depending on individual program requirements.

To achieve this, the PAC Coach must provide high quality football coaching and actively deliver the Club's outcomes by:

- Embodying the club's values.
- Committing to a culture of continuous improvement and professional development.

Position Responsibilities	
Responsibility	Deliverables
Coaching Delivery	 Assist with PAC set up, pack down, cleaning of equipment and other logistical tasks as required. Deliver PAC sessions, Selection Days and Regional Masterclass Camps. Lead the delivery of the PAC curriculum as either a head coach or assistant coach as required. Ensure delivery is in line with the PAC coaching curriculum and methodology. Assist in the retention and re-selection of young player transitioning from the Pre-Academy to the Academy as well as from age to age within the Pre-Academy. Assist Academy coaches and staff as required.
Planning & Organisation	 Contribute to the planning and evolution of the PAC coaching curriculum and methodology for all ages of the PAC. Ensure sessions are recorded on a session planner tool and submitted to the Football Pathway Manager. Ensure delivery of all PAC coaches' sessions are professional, in line with the values and expectations of the Club. Record PAC attendance. Transport PAC equipment and branding as required. When operating in a leading capacity: Planning and communicating the PAC coaching roster. Liaise with facility hosts as directed by the Football Pathways Manager. Manage the day to day running of the PAC including venue set up, participant welcome and registration. Complete incident reports and facility queries, submitting these to the Football Pathways Manager. Ensure all equipment is transported, maintained and stored appropriately on an ongoing basis.
Feedback & Administration	 Complete session reflections and submit to the Football Pathways Manager. Provide individual reviews and feedback forms at the conclusion of each phase of the PAC, via the PAC player phase report card. Provide feedback regarding trialist PAC players. Complete administrative duties set by the Football Pathways Manager.
